Eligibility:

Applicants must be **nominated by a staff member** involved with their High School program or community recycling effort.

Preferred applicants will be pursuing a career in an environmental field.

Criteria:

A 500-word essay, (see application for details).

One personalized letter of recommendation from the staff member who nominated them.

Transcript of applicant's grades.

Deadline:

Applications should be emailed and received by the sponsor no later than 3:00pm on April 2nd. **See application for details.

The Southeastern Indiana Recycling District (SEIRD) is pleased to announce their **2021 Students Making an Environmental Difference** scholarship for graduating High School seniors in their district. Pending adequate submissions, multiple award winners may be selected from the entries received from: Franklin, Jefferson, Jennings, Ohio, Ripley, Scott, and Switzerland County High Schools. The minimum individual scholarship will be \$500 with a combined total not to exceed \$7,000.

To apply, applicants MUST BE NOMINATED by a staff member involved with their High School recycling program or having knowledge of a students' participation in a community recycling effort. Preferred applicants will be pursuing a career in an environmental field to be eligible for a SEIRD scholarship. Each High School may have multiple nominees. We are looking to assist those students that have given their time and efforts towards making their school or community more environmentally responsible.

Nominated applicants must complete and submit the attached 2021 "Official Scholarship Application" form along with the following:

1. A 500-word essay that specifically addresses the following:
 - a. How would you encourage more people in your community to recycle?
 - b. How have you promoted recycling efforts in your area/school?
 - c. How does your career path focus on improving the environment?
2. **ONE personalized** letter of recommendation from the staff member that nominated them
3. A transcript of the applicant's grades

Winners' will be announced by a SEIRD representative prior to the students' Senior Day awards program. Awardees may be photographed for promotional purposes and have their information submitted to a local paper. A senior picture may be requested as well.

The Scholarship monetary awards will be sent directly to the students' confirmed school of higher education. All winners will be issued a packet that includes a list of documentation required for SEIRD to issue a check to a college/business/trade school. This information must be received at the SEIRD office by December 31, 2021 or Scholarship may be forfeited.
